

TMQ's products include digital/analogue intercom, electronically synchronised steering, roll activated emergency exit lighting, alarm monitoring systems, entertainment systems as well as an established range of autopilots and steering accessories.



In August 2019 AMI Group and French energy conversion specialist ENAG commenced a Joint Venture agreement to service the energy requirements of Naval defence and commercial vessels in the region, this JV entity is known as Enpower Australia Pty Ltd.

Local manufacture and assembly includes a complete range of solutions, from diesel-electric propulsion to energy management using ENAG's marine chargers, DC load banks, UPS and DC back up power supplies (for Global Maritime Distress and Safety System – GMDSS).

ENAG power converters, frequency converters and UPS systems are used on both surface vessels and submarines, powering applications as diverse as oxygen plants, missile launchers or power supplies for navigation equipment.



PROJECTS - DEFENCE AT SEA

Desalination

The AMI Group supplied Water Maker Units to ASC for the Collins Class Submarine Program
to overcome water production issues with the original systems. These were a design modified
commercial unit which produced 4 times more water at a 10th of the original cost. These units are still
being supplied and serviced now from AMI WA Head Office to ASC.

Communications

- The AMI Group supplied the Armidale Class Patrol Boats internal communications system in PA/GA System which is in operation and being serviced now.
- During an extensive project, AMI planned, designed, supplied and integrated communication and surveillance systems for the ACV Thaiyak Border Protection Vessel.
- AMI carried out comprehensive installations across a large network for the HMAS Sirius Naval Tanker: The vessel's LDK-300 PABX consists of 28 Analog phone lines, 24 Digital phone lines and 27 Intercom lines in 3 loops - Conning Intercom x 17 Stations, Helicopter Intercom x 3 Stations and Weapons Intercom x 7 Stations.

Navigation

 On board Armidale class vessel Hull 328, AMI provided supply of echo sounders, GPS, Satellite Compass, Autopilot, MF/HF radio system, EPIRBS, SARTS and handheld VHF radios, ship alarms, as well as Satcom systems from SeaTel.

Marine Equipment

- The AMI Group have supplied Windscreen Wipers and Spray systems for the LHD Royal Australian Navy Vessels and 100's of commercial systems over the last 37 years.
- AMI supply UV resistant anti glare blinds for naval and commercial vessels including the HMAS Canberra, which reduce heat and greatly enhance visibility.

Electrical

• The AMI Group have supplied Main AC Switchboards, DC Switchboards and Distribution Boards through their Cairns Office – i.Power Solutions. These units are fabricated in Cairns works include but not limited to: cabinet fabrication, bus bar, frames, painting, wiring and all switchboard requirements. This experience is not specific to Naval (RAN), commercial (such as Hydrographic vessels with electrical switchboards fabricated by i.Power) and large leisure vessels but includes complete fabrication of systems for mine and industrial sites. Components used are as required and utilize Schneider, ABB, Siemens, EATON and similar products pre-approved for class.

SOLAS Safety

• The AMI Group have a fully authorised Safety Group Division and in house servicing of Liferafts, Life Jackets, EPIRBS and other safety equipment in many stations around Australia, including service of liferafts from Naval vessels berthed in Darwin.

Deployable equipment

The "deployable" range is particularly suitable for all types of 28Vdc power vehicles. Connected to the vehicle power inlet, all electrical and electronic equipment on board can run without discharging the auxiliary battery and without running the vehicle engine.

Distribution equipment

The "distribution" range allows the user to provide distribution of AC and/or DC stabilized electrical energy on the field using several primary sources: Mains AC network, 28Vdc from vehicle or external battery pack.

GPU equipment

The "ADTM and COVALT" power supply ranges are used to supply vehicles like aircraft, helicopters, drones... They are able to supply 200Vac 3-phase 400Hz and 28 Vdc. Easy to use, these ranges of power supplies can be quickly installed and ready for operation.

Vessel Monitoring

 The AMI Group have System Integrated, Supplied Product and Serviced Product for complete Navigation, External Communication, CCTV, Internal Communication, Automation and Satellite based communication systems on many commercial ferries and vessels for 22 years. This is with Australian and Overseas companies like Sembawang Shipyards, Keppel Sing Shipyards, Austal Ships, INCAT Tasmania RAN, US MSC Group. We estimate in the order of 100 vessels in this Electronic System Category.

Marine Equipment


 The Marine Division of the AMI Group supply many products such as: Watermakers (Parker Hannifin Agent), Toilet Systems, Bow Thruster and Stabilizer Systems from small to mid size vessels, Anchor and Winch Systems and more.

Satellite Communications

AMI Connect - an AMI Group company, supply Air time contracts, Satellite Communication and TV
Hardware Systems to various commercial shipping fleets. This includes INMARSAT, IRIDIUM, and
General VSAT Based Systems. All the mentioned Systems are also serviced by AMI Connect or the
AMI Group Service Department.

Electronics

- Another successful project involving AMI, with the commissioning of the majority of navigation, communications, internal comms and AMS systems for the Incat Hull 074 vessel Muslim Magomayev.
- AMI also designed and integrated the LNG UHF intercom system for the fixed bridge station and
 for mobile units carried by the crew. Further refinement of systems included reset of the Bridge
 watch system alarm, VSAT termination and commissioning, and Night Vision Camera testing and
 calibration including crew training to ensure smooth handover and operation.
- AMI completed numerous projects for Strategic Marine Vietnam including supply and installation
 of Public Address systems, Radar and IMCOS telephone systems on board the barge vessel
 'Bhagwan Rocker' Hull 379.
- While based in Darwin, AMI conducted termination and commissioning of a TV Distribution system, a PABX, and a VHF Radio distribution system, as well as upgrades to SatComm systems on board charter vessel 'True North'.
